On the Feast of the Assumption, Tuesday, August 15, 2006, we will celebrate our sixth annual Mass of Thanksgiving at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception on Broadway and Market Streets in Camden, NJ. The Solemn High Tridentine Mass will begin at 7:00 pm and will once again feature the Ars Laus Festival Chorus & Orchestra. The Mass setting chosen for this wonderful day will be the *Missa Dolorosa*, by Antonio Caldara (c. 1670-1736), a composer of the Baroque era. Our Cantor, Mr. Nicholas Beck, a graduate of Westminster Choir College will direct the singing of the Gregorian Propers and Dr. Timothy McDonnell will be the conductor for this Mass. Take extra copies of the Assumption Flyer & give it to your friends. This Choral Mass is a beautiful demonstration of our beloved Catholic Heritage. Don't miss it!

Upcoming Performances: Our organist, Karl Tricomi, has been invited to participate in the 2006 Rome Festival in Rome, Italy. He will perform as harpsichordist in a complete production of Mozart's *Don Giovanni* with the Rome Festival Orchestra. He will also accompany singers from the Rome Opera in works of Poulenc and Strauss. Also while in Rome, Karl will give the European premiere of five of his own works for piano.

Phone Chain Sign Up This Summer: We have decided to create a "Phone Chain" for our parishioners to notify them of cancellations of Sunday Masses, Choral Masses, CCD Classes, and Special events due to weather or other emergencies.
