# A "Natural Death" for NJ's Proposed Assisted Suicide Bill?

Almost **500 postcards** from Mater Ecclesiae parishioners were sent to elected officials throughout New Jersey urging lawmakers to reject the proposed "Death with Dignity" law which would allow terminally patients to end their lives with a suicide pill. Other parishes around the state also joined the postcard campaign.

If the bill is not acted upon by December 31, it dies a "natural death" and must be re-introduced in the new year.

Participants in a recent, informal poll by radio station 101.5 OPPOSED assisted suicide by a margin of 75% to 24%. Legislators, take heed!
