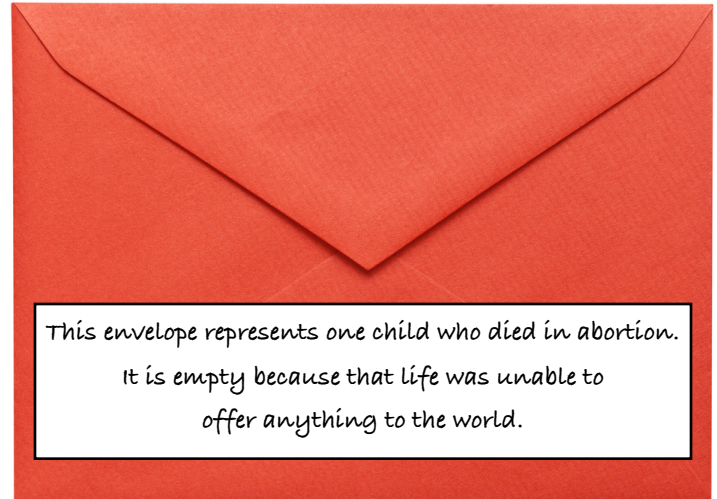
Red Envelope Campaign
