Bishop Sullivan again joins the "40 Days for Life" Campaign at Cherry Hill Abortion Facility

Prayer volunteers outside the Cherry Hill Women's Center on Kings Highway found support and encouragement from His Excellency, Dennis Sullivan, Bishop of the Camden Diocese, as he greeted dozens of men, women, students and children gathered in peaceful vigil, leading them in a recitation of the rosary, for the protection of unborn children, a change of heart for their mothers and families, and for a conversion of the staff working within this abortion facility.

By the grace of God, 40 Days for Life has achieved a stunning track record of life-saving results since launching in 2007 and rapidly becoming a worldwide movement:

750,000 volunteers, 769 cities, 50 nations, 5,605 local campaigns, 15,235 lives saved, 186 abortion workers quit, 99 abortion centers closed
