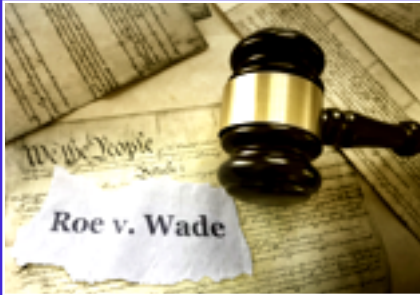

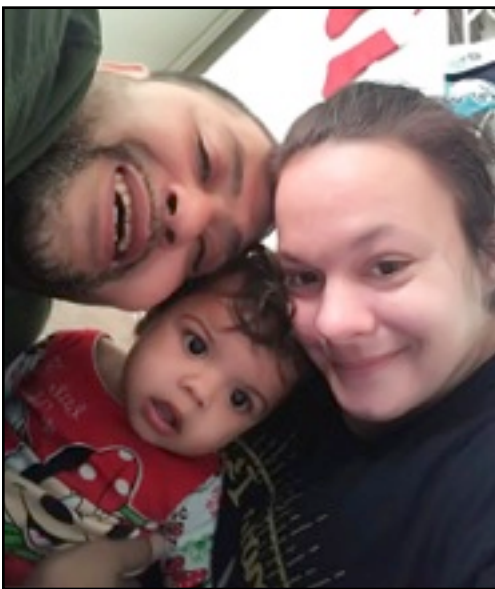

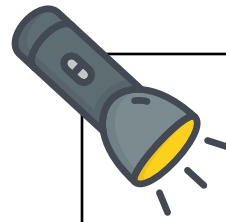

Options is a pregnancy resource center located just down the street from the Cherry Hill Women's (Abortion) Clinic on Kings Highway.
